Terms and Conditions of Loan

- 1. The owner will lend the Mobile Training Unit (MTU) to the borrowing organization according to the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- 2. The MTU shall be loaned from (insert date) until (insert date), also known as the loan period.
- 3. The loan period may be extended by mutual consent of both parties.
- 4. No variation or amendment of this agreement will be effective unless it is made in writing.

Collection and Delivery of Equipment

1. The borrower must arrange a mutually convenient time to collect the MTU on the first day of the loan period and to return it on the last day of the loan period.

Damage Deposit

1. A deposit of \$500 will be required before the MTU will be loaned. The deposit will be refunded within 7 business days, provided that all equipment is returned in the same condition in which it was loaned.

Title and Risk

- 1. Title and all rights to the MTU and its contents shall at all times remain with the owner of the equipment. The borrowing organization acknowledges that it has no right, title or property in the MTU or equipment.
- 2. The owner will ensure that the MTU and equipment is fit for purpose prior to being loaned.
- 3. Risk of any loss or damage to the MTU or equipment will become the responsibility of the borrowing organization upon the start of the loan period and shall not revert back to the owner until the equipment is returned to owner.
- 4. The borrowing organization will ensure that the MTU and equipment to be borrowed is appropriate for its intended use.

Cleanliness

1. The MTU and equipment should be appropriately cleaned prior to the loan period by the MiREMS, and should be returned to the owner at the end of the loan period in clean condition.

MiREMS' Obligations

- 1. Provide the borrowing organization with operating, maintenance and servicing instructions as appropriate.
- 2. Ensure the equipment has undergone the checks detailed in 'Title and Risk', point 2.

Borrower's Obligations

The organization or individual borrowing the MTU and equipment agrees that during the loan period it shall:

- 1. Keep the MTU and equipment in its possession and control and ensure that it is secure against loss, damage and theft
- 2. Operate the MTU and equipment only in accordance with any operating instructions issued, and only for the purpose for which it was designed
- 3. Ensure that the MTU and equipment is used by an appropriately licensed, skilled and trained person
- 4. Any required maintenance and repair of the MTU or equipment shall be performed by personnel approved by the owner.
- 5. Ensure that relevant Health and Safety regulations are met at all times
- 6. Keep the MTU and equipment in good working order, fair wear and tear excluded
- 7. Ensure that identification marks or labels on the MTU or equipment are not removed, defaced, amended, or obscured including those which identify the equipment as belonging to the owner
- 8. The MTU or equipment will not be modified without first obtaining the owners written approval

Loss or Damage of Equipment

In the event of the equipment being lost or damaged:

1. The borrowing organization agrees to pay the replacement cost as indicated below
